We will offer 11–19-year-olds the opportunity to study at a brand new school equipped to the highest standards, with sponsorship from a university, employer partners and other interested bodies.

## SHaW Futures Academy will differ from a mainstream secondary school in several important ways:

- It is backed by a university sponsor and industry partners
- Employers will be actively involved in governing the school – as well as helping to design and deliver the curriculum alongside expert teaching staff
- It will have specialist, purpose-built facilities which replicate real-life working environments
- There will be an extended day for Year 9-13 students (KS4&5) to provide time for employer visits, sport and other enrichment activities
- Students will be fully equipped with the relevant employability skills that are needed for a successful career

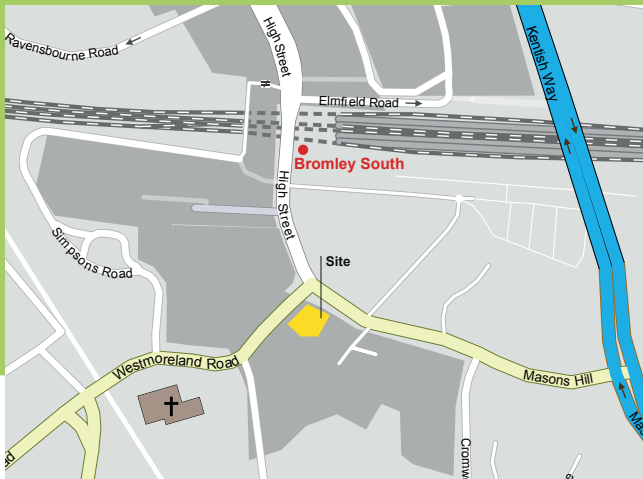
## SHaW Futures Academy is committed to:
